Joan Enderle reported that a \$2500 grant will be given by AAUW for each branch that has had a previous event. The ND legislative funding has been reduced from last year. We will get a \$5000 grant for boys/girls event and will run through the VCSU STEM center. The Steering Committee voted to proceed with Tech Savvy in March 2017.

Jamestown Schools, the University of Jamestown, & the STEM Center have signed on. We already have recruited 5 presenters for girls, but we need a total of 20 presenters for girls and 18 for boys.

Two missing components—people to be in charge of communication/marketing and fundraising. The cost is \$7500 to do this event and will need to do some fundraising. We are still waiting for a financial statement from AAUW, but anticipating we will need to raise \$3000. We do have \$1700 in our account if needed and bookstore funds can be used to help pay for Tech Savvy Event.

Leadership Conference NCCWSL scholarship

Jean Gehrz a senior this year at the University of Mary, Bismarck received our Branch NCCWSL (National Conference for College Women Student Leaders) scholarship to the conference at the University of Maryland, College Park, MD on June 2-4, 2016.

We would like her to tell us about her experiences there. Patsy will make contact with Jean regarding a presentation.

Students choose from more than 50 workshops that will help them prepare them to be a leader in today's world. The student will make lifelong connections with nearly 1,000 women student leaders from across the country and around the world. The woman student leader will also have the opportunity to meet with nearly 100 graduate schools and employers at top companies.

We discussed opening the NCCWSL Scholarship to women interested in leadership not only at UJ, but also VCSU, and Mary College. If we are going to open this opportunity to multiple schools, we need to have a set of guidelines on choosing a winning applicant. The deadline for AAUW early bird registration is April 1, 2017. We will need to start advertising in January as the application is due by spring break (March 5th).
