AAUW State Convention**

On April 14, AAUW members from across the state came to Jamestown for the AAUW North Dakota Annual Meeting and conference hosted by the Jamestown affiliate at the Legacy Center. After a video welcome address by Sen. Heidi Heitkamp, a business meeting of the AAUW state board and a lunch prepared by the James River Senior Center, there was a discussion by the three panelists about how they became first in their respective fields. The panelists were Dr. Polly Peterson, first woman president of the University of Jamestown; Superintendent Dr. Rosalie Etherington, first superintendent of the North Dakota State Hospital, and Judge Cherie Clark, first female district judge of the North Dakota Southeast Judicial District. Moderator Joan Enderle presented prepared questions and took questions from the audience. The three women were given gift baskets from the Dakota Store.

Additional activities included leadership training, installation of officers and an awards ceremony. Officers for the AAUW 2018-2019 state board are Theresa Leiphon, president; Connie Lillejord, secretary, and Von Da Lee Grandalen, membership chair. The Woman of Distinction Award was presented to Renelle Bertsch and Alexa Ducioame, with LuAnn Stromme receiving honorable mention. The Devils Lake affiliate received the Prairie Rose Award for its “Miss Representation” program and Fargo-Moorhead received honorable mention for its book sale. The Fargo Moorhead affiliate also awarded the Turtle Award for its diversity program, “BrainSTEM.”

The conference was coordinated by Jamestown affiliate members Debbie Alber, Mary Craft, Enderle, Patsy Klose, Lauren Sako, Jill Schlenker and Joan Slusser.

We cannot move forward without support and engagement from our members, so we encourage you to vote! Here are the details:

- **Voting opens TODAY** and you can [cast your ballot online](#). In order to vote, **you will need your PIN ----- and your member ID -----**. We encourage you to vote online, if possible, since it will ensure that your ballot will be received and counted immediately.
- If you opted to receive *Outlook* magazine, which includes a voter guide in the spring issue, in print copy, you should receive it in your mailbox around April 25. If not, spring *Outlook* is available online now.
- If you have questions or challenges submitting your online ballot — or would like to vote via paper ballot — you may request one by contacting us at [connect@aauw.org](mailto:connect@aauw.org) or calling **800.326.2289 Monday through Friday 10 a.m.–5 p.m. ET**. Requests for paper ballots must be received by **May 7**, and paper ballots must be postmarked by **May 21**.
  - Voting closes on **Saturday, June 9, at 9 p.m. ET**. Results will be announced on **Sunday, June 10**, on AAUW's website.

The AAUW Board of Directors strongly endorses each of these amendments to increase AAUW's influence and empower millions of women and girls in the years ahead. We hope you will join us in this important effort and [cast your vote TODAY](#).

- The AAUW Board of Directors voted in June 2017 to enact the first dues change in almost a decade.
- Effective March 16, 2018, **[national dues will increase](#)**. The total amount due is \$74. National dues are now \$59, State dues are \$10, and local dues are \$5. **The total amount due is \$74.**
- Annual dues currently account for 13 percent of AAUW's annual budget. They help to sustain and grow AAUW's programs and work that advances equity for women and girls. A combination of dues, donations, and corporate and foundation funding is critical to supporting AAUW's salary negotiation workshops, groundbreaking research, advocacy efforts, campus leadership programs, and so much more.

## Tech Savvy for 2018 Update

An update from Joan Enderle (4-30-18)

On the Financial side of the events – Jamestown Branch contributed \$840 for workshop presenter ‘thank you’ gifts, for the meal for the presenters, volunteers and committee. Sodexo did the meal and also provided movie tickets (purchased at a discount) \$90 to UJ students who volunteered. The supplies for workshops, presenter mileage, hotels for presenters staying overnight, etc. was paid for by the ND STEM grant. (\$4,000)

Evaluations from both students and workshop leaders were positive. A problem with the online registration which allowed additional students above the 15 limit was the biggest negative as Jill had to ‘shuffle’ students.

The date for next year will either be Wednesday, March 6, 2019 as first choice or Thursday, March 7, 2019 if there is a conflict on Wednesday. We need to wait for the schedules for potential competing events. Wednesday is Ash Wednesday but the schools said it was not a conflict with religious activities. Presenters may have issues with it being on Ash Wednesday. Teachers were saying they would like to have the 6<sup>th</sup> grade participate again, but if they do, the boys will need to be back at the middle school. We would like someone to take over STEMtastic but haven’t found someone yet.




